land being sick and weak in body, but of sound and dis-
posing mind, memory, and understanding, Considering
the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time
thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs,
I hereby to be the better prepared to leave this world when
it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make
and constitute this my last Will and Testament (re-
voking and annulling all Wills by me heretofore made
in manner and form following:-

First and principally I Commit my soul into the
hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body to the earth
to be decently buried. - and after my just debts and funeral
charges shall have been satisfied and paid. I give and bequeath
as follows (viz):

Imprimis I give and bequeath to my son
Charles W. M^r Mahan the House and premises on which I
now reside - also all and every part remaining of my personal
estate after the payment of my debts with this
express that if the said Ch^r W. M^r Mahan shall de-
part this life without legal heir in direct descent then
I give and bequeath to be equally divided between my

Brother Wm J Reed and Maria Melvina M^o Allan
 than of this bequest to my son.

I do hereby constitute and appoint John J.
 Mullikin to be sole Executor of this my last Will
 and Testament, my entire personal estate to be by him
 sold except six silver tea spoons - they be retained for
 my son.
